

Remote Amazon Fishing Expedition | Ecuador **6 Days / 5 Nights**

Tour Overview

Discover one of the most remote fishing destinations in the Ecuadorian Amazon on this authentic 6-day fishing expedition to Nuevo Rocafuerte, a small frontier town located on the Ecuador–Peru border, approximately 300 km (186 miles) from Coca along the Napo River.

This is a true Amazon wilderness expedition, designed for adventurous travelers who want to explore untouched rivers, remote lagoons and pristine rainforest while fishing in one of the most biodiverse regions on Earth.

Unlike a luxury lodge tour, this expedition includes three nights camping in the rainforest, surrounded by nature, campfires and unforgettable wildlife. Only the first and last nights are spent in a comfortable hotel with private bathroom, hot shower, air conditioning and Wi-Fi (when available).

During the expedition, all equipment, food and camping supplies are transported by canoe as you travel through the Yasuni River, Hatuncocha Lagoon, Tambococha Lagoon, Napo River and Aguarico River.

Please note that electricity, internet access and mobile phone signal are limited or unavailable during most of the expedition. This tour is perfect for travelers seeking a genuine Amazon adventure far from civilization.

Basic description of the itinerary.

Day 1 – Journey to the Amazon Frontier

- > Meet your guide in Coca at 8:00 AM and board a high-speed motorized canoe for an unforgettable journey down the Napo River to Nuevo Rocafuerte.
- > Along the way, enjoy spectacular Amazon scenery and opportunities to spot macaws, parrots, toucans, kingfishers, herons, monkeys and other wildlife.
- > After arriving in Nuevo Rocafuerte, check into your comfortable hotel and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant while your guide provides an overview of the expedition.
- > Accommodation: Hotel in Nuevo Rocafuerte

Day 2 – Into the Wild Amazon

- > After breakfast, travel by canoe along the Yasuni River toward the remote Hatuncocha Lagoon.
- > Set up camp before beginning your first fishing adventure for Peacock Bass, Piranhas, Catfish and other native Amazon fish.
- > Later, enjoy a short guided rainforest walk to discover giant Ceiba trees, medicinal plants and learn about the incredible biodiversity of the Amazon.
- > After dinner, relax around a campfire beneath the rainforest sky.
- > Optional Activity: Night canoe excursion to search for black caimans, spectacled caimans and fireflies.
- > Accommodation: Jungle Camp

Day 3 – Hatuncocha & Tambococha Lagoons

- > Spend the day exploring Hatuncocha Lagoon, Tambococha Lagoon and the narrow jungle channels connecting these spectacular waters.
- > Fish in some of Ecuador's most remote Amazon fishing locations while enjoying excellent opportunities to observe macaws, parrots, toucans, monkeys, giant otters and many other rainforest species.
- > You may also have the rare opportunity to see or hear the legendary Arapaima (Paiche), the largest freshwater fish in the Amazon. Although it is extremely intelligent and very difficult to catch, it is sometimes seen surfacing to breathe or making impressive jumps in the lagoons.
- > After dinner, guests may join an optional guided night rainforest walk to search for frogs, insects, spiders, tarantulas and other fascinating nocturnal wildlife.
- > Accommodation: Jungle Camp

Day 4 – Napo River Fishing Expedition

- > Continue your expedition exploring remote sections of the Napo River, fishing hidden channels, flooded forests and untouched Amazon waters.
- > Your guide will choose the best fishing locations according to river conditions and fish activity.
- > Enjoy another unforgettable evening around the campfire while surrounded by one of the world's richest ecosystems.
- > Accommodation: Jungle Camp

Day 5 – Aguarico River & Pink River Dolphins

- > Enjoy your final morning of fishing before continuing toward the beautiful Aguarico River.
- > This area offers excellent fishing opportunities and is also one of the best places to observe the incredible Pink River Dolphins in their natural habitat.
- > During the afternoon, return to Nuevo Rocafuerte and relax at your comfortable hotel after several unforgettable days in the Amazon rainforest.
- > Accommodation: Hotel in Nuevo Rocafuerte

Day 6 – Return to Coca

- > Depart early by scheduled speedboat for the return journey along the Napo River to Coca.
- > Arrive around midday, bringing your unforgettable Amazon Fishing Expedition to an end with memories of world-class fishing, spectacular wildlife and one of the last truly wild places in the Ecuadorian Amazon.

Important Information

- > This is a true Amazon wilderness expedition, not a luxury lodge tour. Travelers should expect basic but comfortable camping conditions, limited electricity and little or no internet or mobile phone service while in the rainforest. The reward is an authentic adventure in one of the most remote and pristine regions of the Ecuadorian Amazon, where every day brings opportunities for incredible fishing, wildlife encounters and unforgettable experiences.
