

Waorani Tribe 8 Days Expedition Tour

During this expedition, you will have the opportunity to explore the most remote jungle of the Ecuadorian Amazon, declared as the place with the greatest biodiversity on the planet, (Yasuni National Park and the Huaorani Tribe Territory).

The Yasuni National Park, declared by UNESCO as a biosphere reserve, covers two territories of non-contact tribes called Tagaeris and Taromenanes.

The huge unexplored jungle of the Huaorani tribe is located next to the Yasuni National Park and share same kind of jungle and wildlife, it is the best place to observe flora and fauna in their natural state and many to discover.

Recommended place for lovers of wildlife, extreme adventure activities, biologists, scientists, tribal experiences, animal and bird photographers.

Difficulty level to explore: Moderate, difficult and very difficult.

Basic description of the itinerary

Day 1

the tour starts from Coca City

Very early a staff of our company will meet you at your hotel and then we will leave in a car towards the Shiripuno river bridge where we will take a motor canoe for 3 hours until you reach a good place in the beach or at the side of the river to stay the first night camping.

After dinner.

If we camp at the beach, we will do fire in the night and talk about the jungle life.

Day 2

Long Day Navigation down river until we reach a place close to a animals Clay Lick.

This day During the navigation we have the possibility to see different wildlife that lives and comes to the river and different birds, parrots and toucans.

Lunch at half way.

Camping.

Fire at night.

Relax.

Day 3

If it is not raining, we will start hiking early to an animal's clay Lick, where if we have luck we can see jungle turkeys, parrots, macaws, and very rare wild pigs, monkeys and other rare animals that come to eat the clay and salty water that comes out of the wall.

Navigation down the river until we can reach the Bamenno community, if we have luck around here, we can see the pink dolphin.

Meat the locals.

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Day 4

Visit a lagoon in search of the anaconda (the largest snake in the world).
Visit a Ceibo tree.
Piranha fishing sport.

Day 5

Visit to a Clay Lick area (salty minerals) looking for macaw and other animal species.
Walk through the forest looking for different species of birds and learn about medicinal plants.
Swimming in the river.

Day 6

Day of life
One of the old Huaorani Man will show us all his hunting materials and he will teach us how to prepare the curare poison, and after we will be practicing and using his hunting materials.

Day 7

Return up river until we reach a good place to camp.
Today will be the longest canoe ride and here we will have the probability to watch different kinds of monkeys, birds, parrots and with luck we can find anacondas, tapir, otters, and other big animals.
Box lunch
Camping.
Dinner.
Fire night.

Day 8

Departure until reach the bridge of the Shiripuno River, where we will take private car arriving around 4 pm at your hotel in Coca City, here will be the end of our lovely wild expedition tour.

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NOTE. we reserve in advance to mention it that the itinerary is ready to change in case of bad weather or natural disasters, all this thinking about the safety and comfort of the visitors.

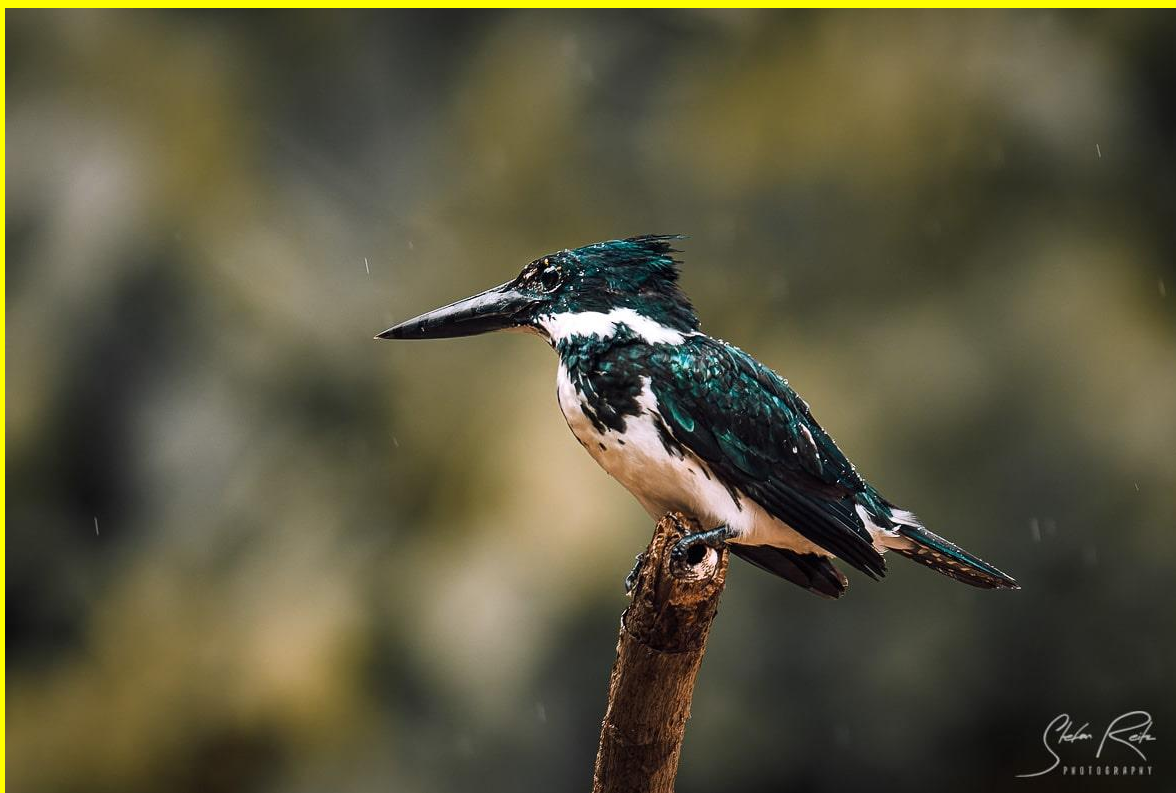

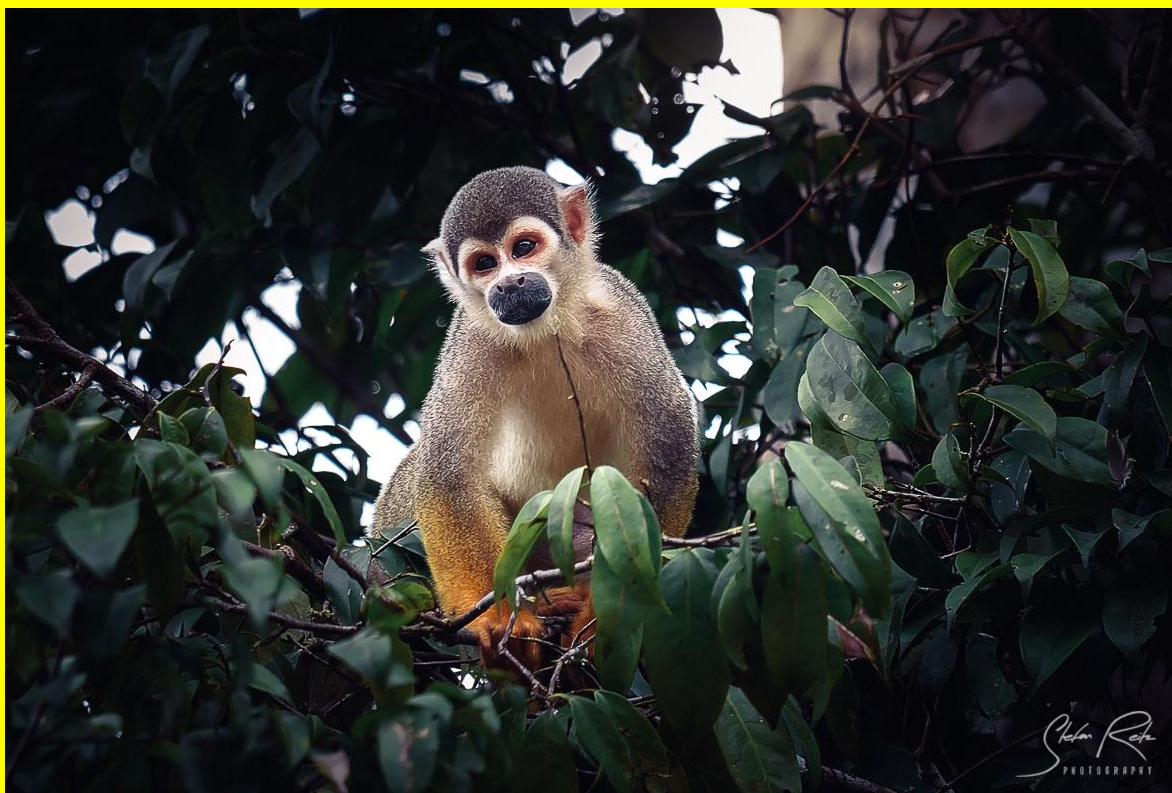

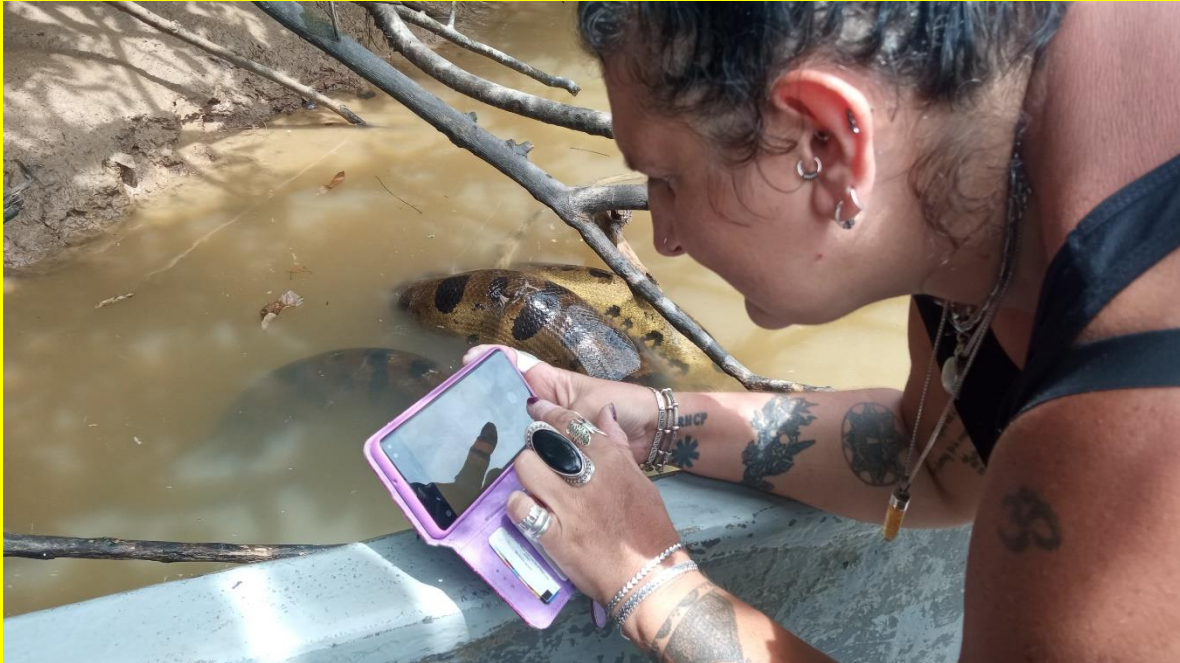












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
