Yasuni & Huaorani Tribe 6 Days Expedition Tour

Ecuador the most biodiversity country in the world. The most of that biodiversity it is concentrated at the Amazon Rainforest. Most species of plants and animals live within their mysterious virgin forests, protected in Yasuní National Park and Huaorani tribe territory reserve.

The most remote and last community of the Huaoranis tribe "**Bameno**": is located approximately 95 kilometers away by land from the town of Puerto Francisco de Orellana (El Coca), and another 200 kilometers by waterway (motor canoe) from Shiripuno River.

How to get to Coca City?

From Quito the Capital of Ecuador. By air or land, you must arrive to the Puerto Francisco de Orellana mostly know like, El Coca.

By Air from Quito to Coca City 30 minutes flight.

The airlines companies, which fly from Quito to Coca City, are Aeroregional and LATAM and the ticket price are around \$ 150 USD

By public bus from Quito to Coca City 8 hours.

You have to take a public comfortable bus, from the Bus Station (Terminal Quitumbe), located at south part of Quito. From here, you have a different bus companies going straight to Coca every 2 hours, take the route Quito-Loreto-Coca (8 hours) and the prices are around 15 dollars.

By private Car or Taxi 5 hours.

We have the contacts of private car or taxi and the prices are from 200\$ - 250\$.

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Example Itinerary

Day / time / activities

Day 1

At 9 am, we will leave the city of Coca in private transport along the Auca highway, approximately 2 hours until we reach the port of the Shiripuno River.

Here is a checkpoint of the Ministry of the Environment where they will ask us for the vaccination card against yellow fever, covid 19 and the passport.

Then we will take a motorized canoe to navigate to a small Huaorani community (Gaba's house) where we will camp the first night.

During the canoe trip to get here, with luck we can observe turtles, macaws, monkeys, toucans, alligators, among others.

After dinner, we will have a cultural exchange and talk about the area and the life history of the Huaorani jungle.

DAY 2

After breakfast, we continue our journey along the river until we reach the community of Bameno.

During the trip, we will enjoy the beauty of the jungle that surrounds us and the animals that we can see from our canoe, later we will stop at the beach for lunch. We will arrive in Bameno and set up our tent where we will spend the rest of the nights.

Night walk.

Day 3

Visit an animals Clay lick.

Visit a lagoon in search of the anaconda (the largest snake in the world) and piranha fishing.

Night navigation looking for alligators (caimans).

Day 4

walk through the jungle with one of the oldest Huaorani hunters, learning his skills and using his jungle weapons. During this hike with luck, we can see jungle pigs, poison frogs and different species of birds.

At night, we will have a typical dance demonstration.

Day 5

After breakfast start coming back until half way where we will camp in the beach of the river.

Here if we have time we can swim and fish in the river. Fire night.

Day 6

After breakfast, we continue upriver and around noon, we will be at the main port of Shiripuno, where we will take our private car to Coca.

Around 4 pm, we will be in the city of Coca.

This will be the end of our tour.

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IMPORTANT: The itinerary is subject to change to safeguard the safety of the passengers, all due to force majeure, unforeseen events or the negligence of third parties.

We remind you that the activity of animals also depends a lot on the weather and walking without noise is important.

For these tours to very remote locations, all logistics and personnel are booked in advance. We are clear in saying that after starting the tour money refunds are not accepted.

Accommodation: in individual tents and matrimonial (is provided with insulation, pillow, towel and sheet).

Included.

3 meals per day, purified water 24 hours a day, camping, rain poncho, rubber boots, Jungle guide Spanish-English speaker, local guide Huaorani-Spanish speaker, land and river transportation from Coca, activities specified in the program, First Aid Kit, entrances.


Not included.

What to bring:
